New Standards for Treated Lumber. The American Wood Protection Association (AWPA) recently changed its standard on lumber treated for ground contact use. The change: Above-ground applications must now adhere to (UC4A) ground contact requirements when the wood will be in any of the following scenarios: Difficult to maintain, repair or replace (such as deck joists and ledger boards) and are critical to the performance and safety of the entire system/construction.

The American Wood Protection Association (AWPA) is a non-profit organization that has long set the standards for treated wood used in residential and commercial applications. AWPA Standards are purely informational, but they are often referenced in federal, state, and local building code laws.

"AWPA U1" signifies that the wood is treated in accordance with AWPA Standard U1, the primary specification for treated wood. The AWPA Use Category designation (for example, "UC2", "UC3B", "UC4A", etc. - see below for descriptions) indicates the proper usage of the treated wood product.

the applicable standard, usually "U1" on the end tag. It's also important to look for the preservative code and retention (amount of preservative retained in the wood), for example, "ACQ-D" or "CA-C".
