We are a heavenly people living upon the earth, and to live worthily means just that – to live the heavenly life on earth! A Worthy Life is a HUMBLE Life (verse 2) The word “ humble ” means to be selfless, utterly lacking in self-assertiveness. Look up Matthew 11: 29; Philippians 2:3; Titus 3: 2; and James 1: 21.
